Jamie holds a BIS (biology, visual arts, dance) from the U of MN and an MA in anthropology from UH Manoa. She is a lecturer at KCC and the Program Manager at the Hawaii Nature Center.



Tara Mariquita Makua (Instructor) has been performing for 20+ years with notable companies such as Berkeley Repertory Theater and the San Francisco Mime Troupe. She holds a BFA in Acting from NYU Tisch School of the Arts. Tara's unique style of ensemble theater combines clowning, dance, physical theater, and self-scripting.
